SMS is designed only for the students of KUTKM where they can enjoy the forum, upload and download services and others more. SMS is a place for students to post any kind of (acceptable) suggestions, comments, public discussions, announcements and any other notices. Other functions in the web forum include statistic reviews, hot topic of the month and bulletin board. Alumni function in this forum is to provide a place for the students to search for KUTKM graduates. The parent of KUTKM students can also access this system in order to view their children progress. This system is also build to take into consideration the computerized decision support system in managing student problem and concern in the campus. SMS is believed to be a very popular site among the students of KUTKM after it is being implemented into the real system.

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CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Preamble

University Information System (UIS) develop as a basic system for KUTKM to build their system altogether effectively, which Student Management System (SMS) implement as a part of UIS. It is important because KUTKM is a new public higher level institution (IPTA) in Malaysia. KUTKM needs to enhance the system used to convince everyone who joins KUTKM so they feel satisfied with services provided. All system in KUTKM builds covered employee works based on staff requirements and student learning environment such as upload and download notes, assignment, tutorial etc. but there is no such system implemented by focusing on university student life problem.

1.1.1 Research Purpose

Student Management System (SMS) is a web community service site that is specially designed only for the usage of KUTKM students.

What makes the students feel better after surfing through this portal is mainly because of the information provided, the easy browsing of the web page and also the user-friendly functions and interfaces being designed.

1.1.2 Research Scope

The most important part of the portal is that it provides a place for the students to share and exchange their ideas. In addition, it is a place for points of view of certain topics for the students to announce any upcoming events being held around the university. This SMS also applied concept of computerized Decision Support System (DSS) in managing student progress from time to time. This concept is applied by allowing the students to enter their own academics information which later generated into a statistic.

Moreover, they can also upload their project and assignment into the portal and share among themselves. It is most useful where the students can download the projects remotely from anywhere in the world with an Internet connectivity. Most benefits can be gained during holidays, because of the distance constraint among the students, where most of them live very far all around Malaysia.

1.1.3 Assumptions

The SMS web portal will be offering much more services and functions, graphics and interactive programs which will not be found in the existing web of KUTKM before. Another problem with the existing web forum is the discussions and conversations of all members are being displayed widely and openly to all users. SMS solve this problem by providing a grouping service where the information of all discussions is only to be view by the authorized group members. The most worrying problem is the security of members' data, files sharing and information being posted to the portal. Privacy issue is one of the factors being considered where access only limits the members to KUTKM students with a valid matrix number according to their faculty. All members are committed to the Rules and Regulation fixed by the administrator.

1.2 Problem Statements

Student Management System (SMS) is the systems that will be used by KUTKM student in their studies environment management or better known as student campus life.

SMS portal is developed based on a few problems that had arisen in the existing web and forum. Following are the listing of the problems that had arisen.

i. **Privacy is not taken seriously**

The existing web forum is similar to public discussion group where the conversations are wide open and general. There is difficulty in maintaining privacy since many users are communicating in a same shared environment which is exposed to the public. This is because the existing web forum records all the messages on the screen. It also makes data available about each user's interaction during a communication session. Information such as who the user was interacting with at any given point in a conversation is made public but this might not be desirable at all times.

ii. **Hard to implement the unity among undergraduates in the existing web**

The existing web emphasize on homework distribution and learning purpose through downloading of notes and so on. This is not meant for active interaction between students. Therefore, the web forum does not serve as a medium to unite the KUTKM community.

Following are the types of users who can utilize the SMS portal:

i. **Database Administrator**

The function of the database administrator is to check the valid students' matric number in the database during the registration process is taken. Besides that, the database administrator also needs to validate the identification of the students when they log in to the portal using the login name and password

they have registered earlier. This is to prevent unauthorized user from damaging the portal and database.

ii. Undergraduates of KUTKM

The SMS portal is particularly for the undergraduates of KUTKM only. The students need to have a valid students' matriculation number in the database in order to become a registered member of this portal. The students also need to specify a login name and password during the registration process to enable them to enter the portal in future.

The function of the students is to participate in the topic discussions inside SMS web forum to enable them to keep track of the latest happenings and information. Moreover, the students can keep in touch with the other registered students by exchanging ideas and thoughts.

1.3 Objectives

Below are the listed objectives of the system.

i. Enhance the current web forum functionality by adding new features

SMS provides a variety of functionality to explore such as upload and downloading the things that they want to share with other registered users like notes and sample coding, photographs and etc. There is also a guestbook function to make the environment more user friendly by letting the user to manipulate the system.

Besides that, it is a place for students to post any kind of suggestions, comments, public discussions, announcements, and any other notices that are acceptable.

ii. To make the web more personalized and private

Due to maintain the privacy of the user, SMS is specially design to improve the performance of the existing web by introducing a member's only groups or community. SMS web forum is only open to the KUTKM students

who have a valid matriculation number. All the discussions and file sharing happens inside the SMS web are private and safe from any interception or interruption from other unauthorized users.

iii. Improve the web interface design to give the users a new feel

SMS has a brand new layout which gives the students a refreshing feel. The use of colors, contrast and images are well designed to make the web page appear to be more user-friendly and easy to navigate around. Most importantly, they do not feel bored with graphics placed all around without systematic alignment.

iv. Enhance unity of KUTKM community by increasing interactivity among students

This portal will strengthen the relationship among undergraduates through sharing of the latest updates and exchange of information in the KUTKM community. The information will be more leisure and interest or hobbies oriented to attract the participation from the students. The level of communication among the students with others will increase because of frequent visit to the portal. Indirectly, they will feel united and belong to one big family. For instance, they can exchange opinions, discussing problems and express their feeling to share with all and getting advice from expert on certain subject.

1.4 Scopes

The SMS portal mainly serves as a medium to strengthen the relationship among the community of KUTKM. Being a method to bring everyone together, it makes all the undergraduates to feel as being part of the institution. Therefore, it is the aim of this project to provide the best of services and functionalities to carry the role of organizer, building credibility and trust among the participants.

As the name of the portal suggest, the main function of this portal is being a web forum to provide a platform for information dissemination. Information can be in the form of (acceptable) suggestions, comments, announcements or notices. The members also get to hold discussions whenever necessary concerning homework or assignments, sports and co-curriculum activities, events and happenings, clubs and societies and many more. To add interactivity and fun to the forum, members will be given the opportunity to participate in various activities. Besides that, the portal also covers six other functions as follows: -

i. Members Registration

Visitors who would like to access the functions and services provided by the portal are required to fill up relevant information to become a registered member. The members consist of KUTKM students and parents. It should be a fast and easy process as most of the information is already stored in the database, which can be retrieved and validated upon registration.

ii. Members Login

This will be a common procedure for members to access the services. They will need to enter login name and password for validation purpose.

iii. Upload and Download Function

Members who are willing to share notes, sample coding and so on are free to upload them on the web so that other members are able to download them for reference.

iv. Guestbook Signing

All visitors are welcome to sign the Guestbook and leave valuable comments about the services offered. Among the assumptions taken in the development of this portal is that the network traffic will be the highest during break hour. Besides that, not all the undergraduates will become a member.

In developing this portal, the most frequently used programming languages software will include JavaScript, Apache Serve, PHP, MySQL, XHTML and HTML. SMS also emphasize on the 3-Tier Technology which

consist of Apache server and MySQL function as the database. Other software to be used for development will be Adobe Photoshop, Adobe Premiere, Adobe ImageReady, Macromedia Dreamweaver and etc.

1.5 Contributions

This system is focused on the student and parent as the main user. For the student, they can interact among themselves by joining a group after everyone registered as a member. They are able to interact among themselves and create a healthy environment because it concerns with their studies. The student can even also monitor their progress from time to time based on their score. Before this, student can only view their assessment mark towards the end of the semester. But now they are able to key in their own information and aware of their progress throughout the whole semester. Lecturers play an important role in giving a full commitment by providing the student with relevant information.

Parents also benefits from the system. The portal allowed parents to take part in helping their children with their studies. By viewing the statistic progress, parents are able to discuss it among themselves as a family.
