## 2.2.2 Decision Support System (DSS)

### 2.2.2.1 Definitions of DSS

Decisions are the choice of one from among a number of alternatives: a statement indicating a commitment to a specific course of action. "*Decision are unprogrammed to the extent that they are novel, unstructured and unusually consequential. There is no cut-and-dried method for handling the problem because it has not arisen before, or because its precise nature and structure are elusive or complex, or because it is so important that it deserves custom-tailored treatment.*" (Simon, 1977). Decision systems are computer-based programs and technologies that are intended to make routine decisions, monitor and control processes, and aid or assist decision makers on semi-structured and/or non-routine decision situations.

DSS are computer-based systems that bring information from a variety of sources, assist in the organization and analysis of information, and facilitate the evaluation of assumptions underlying the use of specific models. In other words, these systems allow decision makers to access relevant data across the organization as they need it to make choices. DSS allow decision makers to analyze data generated from transaction processing systems and other internal information sources easily. Finally, DSS allow decision makers the ability to analyze the information in a manner that will be helpful to that particular decision and will provide that support interactively.

According to Sprague and Watson (1996) conceptual models or frameworks are crucial to understanding a new and/or complex system. They define DSS broadly as an interactive computer-based system that helps decision-makers use data and models to solve ill-structured, unstructured or semi-structured problems. DSS couple the intellectual resources of individuals with the capabilities of the computer to improve the quality of decisions (Keen and Scott Morton 1978). The term *decision support system* remains a useful and inclusive term for many types of information systems that support decision making. He humorously adds that every time a computerized system is not an on-line transaction processing system (OLTP), someone will be tempted to call it a DSS (Powell, 1977)

### **2.2.2.2 Types of DSS**

As mentioned earlier, DSS can be classified in many different categories. Amongst the common ones are the following:

#### **2.2.2.3 Data driven DSS**

These DSS has file drawer systems, data analysis systems, analysis information systems, data warehousing and emphasizes access to and manipulation of large databases of structured data

#### **2.2.2.4 Model driven**

The underlying model that drives the DSS can come from various disciplines or areas of specialty and might include accounting models, financial models, representation models, optimization models, etc. With model drive DSS the emphasize is on access to and manipulation of a model, rather than data, i.e. it uses data and parameters to aid decision makers in analyzing a situation. These systems usually are not data intensive and consequently are not linked to very large databases.

#### **2.2.2.5 Knowledge driven**

These systems provide recommendation and/or suggestion schemes which aid the user in selecting an appropriate alternative to a problem at hand. Knowledge driven DSS are often referred to as management expert systems or intelligent decision support systems. They focus on knowledge and recommends actions to managers based on an analysis of a certain knowledge base. Moreover, it has special problem solving expertise and are closely related to data mining i.e. sifting through large amounts of data to produce contend relationships.
